The Chi-Rho is the oldest known monogram of Jesus Christ. It is sometimes known as a “Christogram”. The *chi* and the *rho* are the first two letters of the word Christ (*Christos*) in the Greek language. The *chi* (X) = ch and the *rho* (P) = r. The Greek word *christos* translates the Hebrew word for “Messiah,” which means “anointed one.” Jesus was born to be the promised anointed Priest and King.

### Purification – We Confess Our Sins to God

Minister: If we say we have no sin,

**People: We deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us.**

Minister: If we confess our sins,

**People: He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to purify us from all unrighteousness.** *1Jonn 1:8-9*

Minister: Let us therefore humbly confess our sins to God our Father. (kneeling)

**O King and Father, your Son died and was raised up in power. Now enable us to die to our sin in repentance so we may rise to new life in Him. We confess to you: Lord, though you should guide us, we inform ourselves; though you should rule us, we control ourselves; though you should fulfill us, we console ourselves. We think your truth too high, your will too hard, your power too remote, your love too free. But they are not! And without them, we are of all people most miserable. Now heal our confused minds with your word, heal our divided wills with your law, heal our troubled consciences with your love, heal our anxious hearts with your presence, all for the sake of your Son, who loved us and gave himself for us. Amen!**

\* Minister: Now lift up your heads, arise, and hear the good news! God, our heavenly Father, has had mercy on us. He has given His only Son to die for us, and for His sake forgives us of all our sins.

\* **People:** Thanks be to God! Our sins are forgiven in Jesus' name. Amen.

### Ascension – God Consecrates Us by His Word

Minister: Lift up your hearts! *Psalm 86:4*

**People:** We lift them up to the Lord! *Lam 3:41*

Minister: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God!

**People:** It is proper and right to do so! *Psalm 92:1*

### "Jerusalem the Golden, the Beloved Bride of Christ"

Text: Psalm 122

- 1, *I was glad when they said to me, "Let us go into the house of the LORD."*
  - 2, *Our feet have been standing within your gates, O Jerusalem!*
  - 3, *Jerusalem is built as a city that is compact together,*
    - 4, *Where the tribes go up, the tribes of the LORD, to the Testimony of Israel, to give thanks to the name of the LORD.*
    - 5, *For thrones are set there for judgment, the thrones of the house of David.*
    - 6, *Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: "May they prosper who love you.*
    - 7, *Peace be within your walls, prosperity within your palaces."*
    - 8, *For the sake of my brethren and companions, I will now say, "Peace within you."*
    - 9, *Because of the house of the LORD our God I will seek your good.*

Sunday School will meet at 11:30 am in the sanctuary. Today's lesson on contentment is "The Excuses of a Discontented Heart."

### Heidelberg Catechism – Pt 2 Deliverance: Lord's Day 26 – Holy Baptism

Q 69. *How does holy baptism remind and assure you that Christ's one sacrifice on the cross benefits you personally?*

A. In this way: Christ instituted this outward washing and with it promised that, as surely as water washes away the dirt from the body, so certainly his blood and his Spirit wash away my soul's impurity, that is, all my sins.

Q 70. *What does it mean to be washed with Christ's blood and Spirit?*

A. To be washed with Christ's blood means that God, by grace, has forgiven our sins because of Christ's blood poured out for us in his sacrifice on the cross. To be washed with Christ's Spirit means that the Holy Spirit has renewed and sanctified us to be members of Christ, so that more and more we become dead to sin and live holy and blameless lives.

Q 71. *Where does Christ promise that we are washed with his blood and Spirit as surely as we are washed with the water of baptism?*

A. In the institution of baptism, where he says: "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" (Mt 28:19). "The one who believes and is baptized will be saved; but the one who does not believe will be condemned" (Mk 16:16). This promise is repeated when Scripture calls baptism "the water of rebirth" (Tit 3:5) and the washing away of sins (Acts 22:16).

**Scripture Memory of the Week** This week memorize Galatians 5:22-23; review verses 16-21.  
22. *But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,*  
23. *gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law*
