## "An Evening Prayer for a Dark Night" Text: Psalm 3

1. Many troublemakers rise up against me and say God will not save me (1-2) Selah

- 2. But Yahweh is a protective, glorious shield around me (3)
  - 3. Yahweh hears my prayer whenever and wherever I may cry out to Him (4) Selah
  - 3' Yahweh gives me sleep and awakens me for He is my support (5)
- 2' I'll not fear of 10000 enemies set against me, all around me (6)

1' Yahweh arises to save His people from all our enemies (7-8) Selah

1. Human \_\_\_\_\_: lamenting over increased trouble (1-2; 2 Sa 15)

2. Divine \_\_\_\_\_: standing in a better place with God than men suppose (3-4)

3. \_\_\_\_\_\_ of mind: knowing Immanuel removes fear of the shadow of death (5-6)

4. Divine \_\_\_\_\_: the victory that overcomes the world is faith in the Son of God (7-8)
