## "Arise, O LORD, to Your Resting Place" Text: Psalm 132

- 1, Remember how [David] swore to the LORD until I find...a dwelling place for the LORD
- 8, Arise, O Lord, to your resting place
- 9. Let Your priests be clothed with righteousness, and let Your saints shout for joy.
- 10, For Your servant David's sake do not turn away the face of Your Anointed
- 11, the LORD has sworn in truth to David the LORD has chosen Zion...for His dwelling place
- 14, this is My resting place forever...
- 16, I will clothe her priests with salvation and her saints shall shout aloud with joy.
- 17, There I will make the horn of David grow; I will prepare a lamp for My Anointed.

1.	David's vow to Yahweh: "I'll find a dwelling place for the (1-5)
2.	The procession to Zion the ark to Zion - Arise, O LORD (6-10)
3.	Yahweh's vow to David: "I'll give you a perpetual by My Anointed" (11-12)
4.	His presence in Zion: Yahweh chooses to <i>dwell &amp; rest</i> in His (13-18)
