## "So Great is His Love" Text: Ps 103

- Personal praise: Bless the LORD, O my soul... (103:1-5)
   A. The problem with \_\_\_\_\_\_ (1-2; Dt 8:12-14)
  - B. A \_\_\_\_\_\_ between how God handles *iniquity and diseases* (3; 2 Cor 1:3-4)
  - C. Rescue, \_\_\_\_\_, renewal (4-5)
- Wayward family, gentle Father: He will not always strive...as a father...the LORD pities his... (103:6-14)
  A. It is God's ways & acts to put not only circumstances straight but \_\_\_\_\_\_ (6-7; Dt 8:2-3)
  - B. Man's inconstancy and heavy-handed wrath & God's \_\_\_\_\_ and generosity (8-10)
  - C. Immeasurable \_\_\_\_\_\_ and mercy expressed by immeasurable distances & the intimacy of family (11-14)
- **3.** Fading life, eternal love: man's days are like grass...the mercy of the LORD is everlasting (103:15-18; Ps 90:2; Ep 1:3f)
- Praise from all creation: Bless the LORD, you His angels...all His works...O my soul! (103:19-22)
  A. The King of the universe & His \_\_\_\_\_\_ in the heavens (19-21)
  - B. Not a solo of praise, but a universal choir, each \_\_\_\_\_ having its own part to add in perfect harmony (22)
