**Purification – We Confess Our Sins to God**

**Most merciful God, we confess that we are by nature sinful and unclean. We have sinned against You in thought, word and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone. We have not loved You with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We justly deserve Your present and eternal punishment. For the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy upon us. Forgive us, renew us, and lead us, so that we may delight in Your will, and walk in Your ways to the glory of Your holy name. Amen.**

(Silent prayers of confession are offered.)

Minister: Now lift up your heads and hear the good news! God, our heavenly Father, has had mercy on us. He has given His only Son to die for us, and for His sake forgives us of all our sins.

**People: Thanks be to God! Our sins are forgiven in Jesus' name. Amen.**

**Ascension – God Consecrates Us by His Word**

Minister: Lift up your hearts! Psalm 86:4  
**People: We lift them up to the Lord!** Lam 3:41  
Minister: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God!  
**People: It is proper and right so to do!** Psalm 92:1  
Minister: Truly, it is proper, right, and our duty that we should at all times, and in all places, give praise to You O Lord, holy Father, almighty and everlasting King. Therefore, with angels and archangels and all the company of heaven, and with the Church on earth, we praise and magnify Your glorious Name, evermore praising You and singing:

1. Have been baptized in the name of the Triune God (Matt 28:18-20);
2. Do profess faith in the Lord Jesus Christ as the Son of God, and Savior of sinners, and do rest upon Him alone for salvation as He is offered in the Gospel (Ro 10:9-10);
3. Do live in humble reliance upon the grace of the Holy Spirit and endeavor to live as becomes the followers of Jesus Christ (Gal 5:16-26); and
4. Are communing members in good standing in an evangelical church (1 Cor 10:1-6)

If these things are all true, we rejoice with you and invite you to commune with us at the Lord's Supper. If any of these are not true of you, we ask that you refrain. We invite you to speak to one of the Elders if you have doubts or questions regarding any of these beliefs, or if you are interested in learning more about Lakeside.

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*Though collections are not ordinarily taken during a service, giving is a vital element of worship. Tithes and offerings may be placed in the basket at the rear of the church. (2 Corinthians 9:6-11)*

In corporate worship – when God meets with His people, Christ with His bride, the Spirit with His temple – we receive God's grace through the Word and sacrament, and we respond to Him with thanksgiving, faith, and love.*

## Sermon Notes – January 1, 2012

### "The Gospel According to the Book of *Kings*" (an introduction)

1. The Book of *Kings* is a historical narrative, but not primarily. It is \_\_\_\_\_.

### Scripture Memory

Our new Scripture memory text is Colossians 1:13-23. This week memorize v 13:

*He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love,*

Notes: 1) "He" refers to the *Father* mentioned in v 12, *who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light*. 2) "Conveyed" is rendered "translated" in the KJV. It is the idea "to change or remove." In rescuing us from satan's evil rule, the Father has changed us into His children of Light (cf v 12). He has removed us from darkness by overcoming our blindness with the Light of the Gospel of Christ, and in so doing He has translated (conveyed or changed) us into the Beloved Son's reign of protection and perfect Love.
