

Scripture Memory

Our Scripture memory text is Colossians 1:13-23. This week memorize v 22:

...in the body of His flesh through death, to present you holy, and blameless, and above reproach in His sight--

Note: Here in v 22 "body" refers to the physical body of Jesus in his incarnation, but in v 18 "body" refers to "the church." The one is connected or incorporated with the other (cf Col 3:1-4). The church is identified or "hidden with" Christ in his death, resurrection, ascension and coming again. The "you" in v 22 is not singular speaking of individuals, but plural, "you all" as in Christ's corporate body, the church. By his death, Christ has accomplished the purification of the Church *in his sight*. Paul uses similar language to describe the church as his bride (Eph 5:27).
