- 3. Do live in humble reliance upon the grace of the Holy Spirit and endeavor to live as becomes the followers of Jesus Christ (Gal 5:16-26); and
- 4. Are communing members in good standing in an evangelical church (1 Cor 10:1-6)

If these things are all true, we rejoice with you and invite you to commune with us at the Lord's Supper. If any of these are not true of you, we ask that you refrain. We invite you to speak to one of the Elders if you have doubts or questions regarding any of these beliefs, or if you are interested in learning more about Trinity.

Though collections are not ordinarily taken during a service, giving is a vital element of worship. Tithes and offerings may be placed in the basket at the rear of the church. (2 Corinthians 9:6-11)

#### **Scripture Memory**

Our text is Matthew 5:1-12. This week review v 1-10 and memorize v 11:

Blessed are you when they revile and persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely for My sake.

Notes: V 11 continues the thought of persecution of v 10, but v 11 is personal, *Blessed are you...* instead of *Blessed are those...* V 11 also specifies verbal persecution with the intent to damage your good name and reputation (cf Lu 6:22). There is a time and place to make a defense of our reputation. However, if we are reviled because of our faith in Christ, that is a time to apply 1 Pe 2:23, who, when He was reviled, did not revile in return; when He suffered, He did not threaten, but committed Himself to Him who judges righteously; also 1 Pe 4:14, If you are reproached (insulted) for the name of Christ, blessed are you, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you.
