- 4. Are communing members in good standing in an evangelical church (1 Cor 10:1-6)



Notes: The disciples/apostles of Jesus were acquainted with persecution like many of the prophets of old. Jesus warned them of the cost of discipleship, and they experienced it firsthand. They understood that the enmity God put between the Seed of the woman and the seed of the serpent meant that those who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution (2 Ti 3:12). 1 Pe 2:20-21, when you do good and suffer, if you take it patiently, this is commendable before God...Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example. 1 Pe 3:14, if you should suffer for righteousness sake, you are blessed. And do not be afraid of their threats, nor be troubled. 1 Pe 4:19, Therefore let those who suffer according to the will of God commit their souls to Him in doing good, as to a faithful Creator.
