If these things are all true, we rejoice with you and invite you to commune with us at the Lord's Supper. If any of these are not true of you, we ask that you refrain. We invite you to speak to one of the Elders if you have doubts or questions regarding any of these beliefs, or if you are interested in learning more about Trinity.



#### **Scripture Memory**

Our Scripture memory text is Matthew 5. This week review v 1-11 and memorize v 12:

Rejoice and be exceedingly glad, for great is your reward in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

Notes: V 12 expresses the reward that corresponds to v 11, for those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake. Jesus tells us what He approves of, blessed are the..., then he promises a reward for being faithful in that. Some rewards may be experienced in this life, but they are but a foretaste of something much greater. Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him (1 Co 2:9). In 1 Co 3:8-15, Paul explains that believers who labor faithfully now, according to the grace of God given to us, will receive a reward on the day of judgment. But there is potential for loss of reward, for not building on Jesus Christ. "Crowns" are bestowed on God's saints for loving Him (Jas 1:12), for loving Christ's appearing (2 Ti 4:8), for being faithful unto death (Rev 2:10), and for faithful elders (1 Pe 5:4). Right now counts forever in the matter of one's eternal destiny (faith), and also in the matter of eternal rewards (faithfulness).
