1. Fingers in front of the lampstand (Da 5:5,23,24)

A. “*The finger of God*”

- 1) The finger of God & Pharaoh -- we should \_\_\_\_\_ (Ex 8:16-19)
- 2) The finger of God & creation -- we should be in \_\_\_\_\_ of Yahweh (Ps 8:3)
