Good morning House of God! Greetings in the name of the risen Lord & Savior!

**God Calls us into His presence; we respond with praise.**

\*Call to Worship: Matthew 28:1-10

Minister: Alleluia! Christ is risen!

People: **He is risen indeed!**

Minister: Grace to you and peace, in the name of the Father & of the Son & of the Holy Spirit.

People: **Amen!**

Minister: The Lord be with you.

People: **And also with you.**

**But if we confess our sins, God, Who is faithful and just, will forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.** 1 Kings 8:38,39,47b-50b

**"O Lord, great and awesome God...we have sinned and committed iniquity, we have done wickedly and rebelled, even by departing from Your precepts and Your judgments. Neither have we heeded Your servants the prophets, who spoke in Your name...O Lord, righteousness belongs to You...to us belongs shame of face...because we have sinned against You. To You, Lord our God, belong mercy and forgiveness, though we have rebelled against You. We have not obeyed Your voice to walk in Your laws...therefore the curse in the Law has been poured out on us, because we have sinned against You. I pray, let Your anger and Your fury be turned away. (Silent prayer) Amen! (from Daniel 9)**
