"Bildad Rebukes and Job Responds – show me why You contend with me" Job 8-10

1.	Bildad argues that God is just in all His ways, therefore whoever experiences calamity has sinned. A. He caustically reproves Job for violating God's justice. (8:2-7)
	B. He illustrates from tradition (8:8-10) and nature that God does not pervert His justice. (8:11-22)
2.	Job responds to Bildad (ch 9) and resumes his complaint to God. (ch 10) A. Job ponders the futility of trying to dispute God in court. (9:1-35)
	B. So, Job makes his complaint to God but is left with questions, <i>Why?</i> (10:1-22)
