“Bildad’s Second Speech and Job’s Answer: *I know that my Redeemer lives...*”
Job 18-19

1. Bildad’s second rebuke of Job: *his roots are dried out below...surely such are the dwellings of the wicked.* (ch 18)
 - A. His annoyance with Job’s answers (18:1-4)

 - B. He describes what God does to the *wicked* and implies this is what God is doing to Job. (18:5-21)

2. Job answers: *my hope is uprooted like a tree...yet in my flesh I shall see God.* (ch 19)
 - A. His complaint against the “friends” who are *tormenting* him and have *insulted* him *ten times* (19:1-6)

 - B. His complaint against God for *stripping him of glory, hope, family, friends* (19:7-24, cp 17:15)

 - C. Yet Job hopes in his kinsman-Redeemer, Who will vindicate him. (19:25-29; Lev 25:25ff; Nu 35:19ff; Ruth 4)
