**“Job answers Zophar’s Second Speech: *Can anyone teach God knowledge, since He judges...*”**

**Job 21**

1. Job offers comfort to the friends though he knows they'll *keep mocking* (21:1-6).
  
2. Job challenges their view of divine retribution: *why do the wicked live and become old* (21:7-34).
  - A. The wicked frequently prosper (21:7-16).
  
  - B. Even the wicked know God frequently delays judgment for a generation or two, and they don't care (21:17-21).
  
  - C. Job knows that God knows what He is doing when He judges and how He judges (21:22-26).
  
  - D. Job knows the friends are scheming to wrong him, but he refuses to repent of things he has not done (21:27-34).
