“Can man be righteous before God – Till I die I will not put away my integrity from me”

Job Answers Bildad’s Third speech

Job 25-27:12

1. Bildad’s third speech to Job: ‘It is impossible for a man to be *righteous and pure before God*. Job you’re a *man, a son of man, a maggot and a worm.*’ (ch 25)

2. Job answers Bildad: “So you bring up justice and righteousness and think you understand God?” (ch 26-27)
 - A. He questions Bildad’s righteousness – what have you done to *help, save, counsel, advise* others? (26:1-4)

 - B. He agrees with Bildad that God is just and therefore everything *in heaven, earth and under the earth trembles* at His presence. (26:5-14)

 - C. He *continued to lift up his proverb* on God’s wise justice and rule. (ch 27)
