**Job 31**

1. His covenant of mental and physical fidelity toward the opposite sex (31:1-12)
2. His care for his servants, the poor, widows and orphans (31:13-23)
3. His contentment in God and refusal to worship stuff or created objects (31:24-28)
4. His unwillingness to delight in the misfortune of enemies or sojourners (31:29-32)
5. He confessed his sin because he feared the LORD not public opinion (31:33-40).
