

## Study Notes - November 20, 2022

## "The Parable of the Talents" Matthew 25:14-30

1.	Jesus tells the parable to His disciples (Mt 24:1ff-25:46), because He leaves them in charge of His <i>goods</i> , while He "goes into another <i>country</i> ." (25:14)
2.	Jesus uses symbolism of a kingdom setting: talents, slaves, and the reward of rule. (25:15-23)
3.	Again, Jesus emphasizes that He is coming back, but it will seem like a delay to His disciples: after a long time (25:19,30; cp 24:51)
4.	When Jesus comes, He will settle accounts with His slaves, rewarding the faithful and condemning those who have a wrong creed and agenda. (25:16-18, 24-30)
